### DAY 01: ARRIVE CAIRO (D)

Arrive Cairo International Airport in the afternoon, Meet & assistance service at the airport. Transfer to hotel for check in. Dinner in restaurant.

### Day 02: CAIRO (B/L/D)



After breakfast, proceed to visit Egyptian Museum where 100,00 relics and antiquities from almost every period of ancient Egyptian history, including the treasures of boy King Tuthankhamun are housed here. Giza Pyramids The only survivor of the 7-ancient wonders of the world, the great Pyramids of Cheop, Chephren and Mycerinus. The Sphinx the mysterious statue of a Pharaoh's head with lion body is also known as the " Father Of Fear " lies on the Giza Plateau close to the Pyramids. If time permit , visit famous Khan El Khalili Bazaar. Overnight cairo.

### Day 03: CAIRO / ALEXANDRIA (B/L/D)

Today drive up north to the pearl of the Mediterranean -- **Alexandria**. It is the largest port in Egypt and the greatest summer resort in Middle East its strategically located on the Mediterranean Sea. Upon arrival to Alexandria proceed for sightseeing which includes :**Pompey's Pillars, Catacombs Of Kom El Shukafa, El Montazah Palace Gardens, Qait Bay Fort** ( No entry). Lunch at seafood restaurant, afternoon drive back to Cairo. Dinner at restaurant. Overnight in Cairo

### Day 04: CAIRO (B/L/D)

After breakfast proceed to visit Memphis – Statue of Ramses II – Alabaster ShinxCapital of the old Kingdom , lies the colossal statue of Ramses II and the great Alabaster Sphinx. Sakkara – Step Pyramids of ZoserI Believe to the first and oldest pyramids in the world , dating from 2686BC built for Pharaoh Zoder. Today.Lunch at Local restaurant. Next visit an awesome medieval fortress that was the seat of Egyptian power for 700 years - Citadel of Saladin . Built in 1176 by Salah El Din to fortify the city against the invasion and threat of the crusaders. The Mosque of Mohammed Ali, Mosque of Soliman Pasha and the well of Joseph, are found within the Fort. Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali Located within the Citadel of Saladin. The Mosque was modeled along the Turkish Lines. The Chintzy Clock in the central courtyard was a gift from King Louis Phillpe of France in appreciation for the Pharaonic Obelisk that adorns the Palace De La Concorde in Paris. Overnight in Cairo.

**Day 04: CAIRO (B)** After Breakfast, free at leisure. Overnight in Cairo

**Day 06: Cairo/Departure (B)** After breakfast, free till transfer to the airport for departure flight.
