Grant Pereira is an environmentalist and one of the **FIRST** nature guides to be certified and registered by 'The Singapore Tourism Board,. He specialises in Nature Adventures in the Asean Region and says....."The tropics and it's rainforest have one of the richest biodiversities in the world so there is really no reason to travel outside Asean to experience our rich fauna and flora. Did you know that there is more biodiversity at Bukit Timah Nature Reserve than the whole of North America?"

Besides being a **NATURE GUIDE**, Grant has been an **ACTIVE ENVIRONMENTALIST** for more than 30 years and has been directly involved in conservation efforts to save the endangered Asian elephants in Northern Thailand and the orang utan in East Malaysia and Indonesian Borneo. His elephant conservation trips to Northern Thailand also includes visits to remote hill tribes & schools to volunteer in building houses, schools or classrooms. These trips (5-14 days) are not only popular with schools and green groups but also with companies who send their staff to team build and bond.

For his environmental efforts, Grant has received many awards, the most notable being "**The Greenleaf Award**" in 2000, the HIGHEST environmental award presented by the Minister of the environment on behalf of the Ministry of the Environment. In 2002, Grant also received the "**Life Inspiration Award**" from Mayor Zainul Abidin Rasheed of the NorthEast CDC. This award was in recognition for work he did with young people, inspiring them to be more aware of their environment and make efforts to improve it.
